ALL OVERDUE FINES MUST BE PAID IN ORDER TO PURCHASE A ROAD TEST PERMIT

Bring: Your Drivers Licence (*suspended drivers - 2 pieces of acceptable I.D.*)
Current & valid registration certificate Current & valid insurance liability card

For a road test your vehicle must have:

- a valid licence plate
- working brake, signal and headlights
- a working horn
- steering with no excessive play
- no leaks in the exhaust system
- an unobstructed windshield
- left hand drive vehicles only
- enough fuel to accommodate a test of up to 60 minutes
- functional driver and passenger doors
- a proper seat and working seat belts for you and the examiner
- clean, obstruction free passenger seating
- functional brakes & working park brake
- an accurate speedometer
- adequate mirrors; safe tires

*** failure to meet any of these requirements may result in cancellation of your road test**

Additional Requirements:

Class 2, 3, 4 or 6 – KNOWLEDGE TEST MUST BE COMPLETED
Class 2, 4 - Drivers Medical & Airbrake Certificate (*if the vehicle has airbrakes*)
Class 6 - Motorcycle must be GREATER than 50 cc

ADVANCED ROAD TEST REQUIREMENTS

There are a large number of components to the Advanced Road Test that require a strong demonstration of individual driving skills, standards and techniques. Drivers taking the Advanced Road Test will be required to perform the following:

- making numerous right and left turns
- handling 'through' intersections
- entering and exiting high-speed roadways
- changing lanes
- handling controlled and uncontrolled intersections
- driving in moderate and congested traffic
- handling right and left road curves
- handling controlled and uncontrolled railway crossings
- driving in various speed zones
- driving through playground and school zones
- angle parking
- Hill Parking
- Parallel Parking
